



Nomination of a LCI Charity Project

Every second year at the LCI AGM a LCI Charity Project is elected.

At the LCI Conference 2001 in Heidelberg, Germany – there were 4 LCI Countries applying for the Charity Project 2001-2003. The presentation at the LCI AGM showed that a new procedure for nomination of the LCI Charity Project is needed.

Suggested procedure

At the Midterm Meeting prior to the LCI Conference the nominated LCI Charity Project must be presented for the LCI Councillors.

The presentation must be done by the applying Country National Vice- or President.

The presentation should include a PowerPoint presentation – not longer than 5-8 slides a copy must be given to all member countries – to be used within the country to present the applications that an election can be done at the national AGM.

The presentation must include the goal for the LCI Charity Project. The presentation must include a budget for the LCI Charity project – and a plan, how to collect the sufficient amount of money needed to reach the goal for the LCI Charity Project.

At the following LCI Conference at the Councillors Meeting – the election of the LCI Charity Project will be done and the winner will present the LCI Charity Project during the LCI AGM – where the PowerPoint presentation – can be followed by a short video (3 minutes) to show live pictures from the Charity Project.

To make the election exciting and surprising for the participation Circlers – the announcement of the winner must not be done prior to the LCI AGM.
